

**Statement of Key Decisions of the 139th University Council session
Held on January 21, 2024**

First: General Topics:

- Approval of the cooperation protocol between the Institute of African Research and Studies and the Faculty of Commerce and Business Administration, Helwan University.
- Approval of the cooperation protocol between the Institute of African Research and Studies and the Faculty of Arts, Helwan University.
- Approval of the cooperation protocol between the Faculty of Fish and Fisheries Technology and the Red Sea Ports Authority.
- Approval of the cooperation agreement between the university and Enroot for Investment.
- Approval of the scientific cooperation agreement between the university (represented by the Faculty of Dar Al Uloom) and the Egyptian University of Islamic Culture “Nur-Mubarak” (represented by the Faculty of Languages and the Faculty of Islamic Studies) in the Republic of Kazakhstan.
- Approval of the cooperation protocol between the Faculty of Commerce and the “Future of Egypt” Agency for Sustainable Development.
- Approval of the cooperation protocol between the Faculty of Commerce and the Egyptian Banking Institute.
- Approval of certain amendments to the internal bylaws of postgraduate studies (credit hour system) at the faculty, in accordance with the recommendations of the Antiquities Sector Committee of the Supreme Council of Universities.

Second: Academic Staff Affairs:

- Approval of the appointment of four (4) candidates to the position of Assistant Professor.
- Approval of the appointment of three (3) candidates to the position of Lecturer.

Third: Granting Academic Degrees:

- Approval to grant 14 Doctoral degrees.
- Approval to grant 28 Master's degrees.
- Approval to grant 77 Diploma degrees.
- Approval to grant the succeeded students the Bachelor degree of Medicine and Surgery (First round 2023) that they are 103 students, each with the grade obtained, from the Faculty of Medicine (Old Bylaws).
- Approval to grant succeeded students the Bachelor degree of Medicine and Surgery (First round 2023) that they are 125 students, each with the grade obtained, from the Faculty of Medicine (New Bylaws).

- Approval to grant the Diploma of the Technical Nursing Institute to student Abo Al-Hassan Mahmoud Sayed Khalil, who passed the final year (Round of May 2022) after successfully completing the training period from October 1, 2022 to December 5, 2023, with the grade obtained, in accordance with the new bylaws of the Technical Nursing Institute.
- Approval to grant 224 students various diplomas (Round of July 2023), each according to their specialization and the grade obtained, from the Faculty of Education.
- Approval to grant 16 students various diplomas (Round of September 2023), each according to their specialization and the grade obtained, from the Faculty of Education.
