

## **Statement of the most important decisions of (145) session held on July 21, 2024**

### **First, general topics:**

- Approval of the renewal of the membership of the Minister/Governor of Aswan - effective August 2024 for a period of two years, in light of Paragraph (c) of Article 22 of the Universities Regulation Law promulgated by Law No. 49 of 1972.
- Approval of the establishment of the Faculty of Oral and Dental Medicine and Surgery at Sohag University.
- Approval of the establishment of the Oncology Institute (Research and Therapeutic) at Menoufia University.
