

Statement of the most important decisions of the (149) session

Held on November 25, 2024

First, general topics:

- Approval of the amendment to the bylaws of the Faculty of Energy Engineering (Bachelor's Degree) based on the recommendations of the committee formed for this purpose in cooperation with Arizona State University.
- Approval of holding the third student employment forum (Aswan, Land of Gold) from December 11 to 12, 2024.

Second: academic staff affairs:

- Approval to appoint (4) in the position of Professor
- Approval of the appoint (5) in the position of Assistant Professor.
- Approval of appoint (1) in the position of Lecturer.

Third: granting academic degrees:

- Approval to grant 13 doctoral degrees.
- Approval to grant 18 master's degrees.
- Approval to grant scholarships to 15 successful students in the July 2024 session for various diplomas, each according to his specialization and the grade he obtained from the Faculty of Education.
- Approval to grant the student / Moamen Salah El-Din Abdel-Ghani a diploma in energy engineering in the Department of Electrical Power Engineering, June 2024 session, with the grade he obtained from the Faculty of Energy Engineering.

- Approval to grant the student / Israa Zakaria Muhammad Ismail, who succeeded in the January 2023 session, a special diploma in specific education in the Department of Educational Technology, with a general grade of (Very Good - B) with a cumulative total of 2092 points from the Faculty of Specific Education.

-Approval to grant a bachelor's degree in one of the specialized languages and literatures for the October 2024 session to 5 successful students in the final year, based on the grade they obtained from the Faculty of Alsun.

-Approval to grant a bachelor's degree in Arabic Language, Literature, and Islamic Sciences for the October 2024 session to 20 successful students in the final year, based on the grade they obtained from the Faculty of Dar Al-Ulum (full-time).

-Approval to grant four successful final-year students a Bachelor's degree in Physical Education, one group major and two individual majors, for the October 2024 session. Each student is assigned a Bachelor's degree based on their major and the grade they received from the Faculty of Sports Sciences (old regulations).

-Approval to grant three successful final-year students a Bachelor's degree in Nursing Sciences for the October 2024 session. Each student is assigned a Bachelor's degree based on their grades from the Faculty of Nursing (clearing).

-Approval to grant (4) successful final-year students a Bachelor's degree in Arts for the October 2024 session. Each student is assigned a Bachelor's degree based on their major and the grade they received from the Faculty of Arts (full-time).

-Approval to grant successful students in their final year, October 2024 session, a Bachelor of Arts degree, based on their specialization and the grade they received from the Faculty of Arts (affiliation).
