

Statement of the Most Important Decrees Issued in the 12th Session after the 1st Hundred Ones held on 25th October 2021

First: General Issues

- Approval on starting the postgraduate studies in the faculty of fisheries technology; a master program of sustainable fisheries management and aquaculture funded by the European Union (Erasmus) with credit-hours system according to the specific dates on the internal regulation for postgraduate studies stage.
- Approval on bearing the treatment costs of a number of (1) employee.

- **Approval on** granting (23) diploma degrees to the passed students in the faculty of science.
- **Approval on** granting (6) diploma degrees to the passed students in the faculty of physical education.
